



## **ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION**

The Open Manifesto Association

### **Article I – Name and Registered Office**

1. The name of the association is: The Open Manifesto Association (hereinafter referred to as the “Association”).
2. The Association is established as a registered association under Section 214 et seq. of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., Civil Code of the Czech Republic.
3. The registered office of the Association is: Havlíčkova 155, Ledec nad Sázavou, 58401, Czech Republic.

### **Article II – Purpose**

The purpose of the Association is to support education, research, public awareness, and international dialogue in the areas of human consciousness, human nature, societal systems, culture, ethics, and sustainable development.

The Association focuses in particular on promoting critical thinking, interdisciplinary approaches, and civic engagement, as well as on creating and disseminating both expert and popular materials, organizing educational, cultural, and community activities, and cooperating with individuals and organizations in the Czech Republic, the European Union, and internationally.

### **Article III – Activities**

The activities of the Association include in particular:

- organizing educational, cultural, awareness, and community activities, seminars, discussions, conferences, and public events,
- creating, publishing, and distributing expert, educational, and popular materials in both printed and electronic form,
- conducting research and analytical activities and supporting interdisciplinary collaboration,
- promoting public debate, critical thinking, and civic engagement,
- cooperating with individuals, non-profit organizations, academic institutions, and other entities in the Czech Republic, the European Union, and internationally,
- operating information and communication platforms, including online platforms.

### **Article IV – Secondary Economic Activity**



1. The Association may carry out secondary economic activities, provided that such activities support the main activities and the purpose of the Association.
2. Any income from secondary economic activities shall be used exclusively to support the purpose of the Association.

#### **Article V – Membership**

1. Any natural or legal person who agrees with the purpose of the Association and these Articles may become a member.
2. Admission of members is decided by the Chair of the Association.
3. Membership terminates by withdrawal, expulsion, or dissolution of the member.

#### **Article VI – Bodies of the Association**

The bodies of the Association are:

- the General Assembly,
- the Chair.

#### **Article VII – General Assembly**

1. The General Assembly is the highest body of the Association.
2. The General Assembly shall in particular:
  - approve the Articles and any amendments thereto,
  - elect and remove the Chair,
  - approve the report on the activities of the Association.

#### **Article VIII – Chair**

1. The Chair is the statutory body of the Association.
2. The Chair acts on behalf of the Association independently.
3. The Chair manages the activities of the Association and decides on all matters not entrusted to another body of the Association.

#### **Article IX – Financial Management**

1. The Association manages its assets in accordance with applicable legal regulations.
2. Any profit of the Association shall not be distributed among its members.

#### **Article X – Dissolution**

1. The Association may be dissolved voluntarily or by other means provided by law.



2. Upon dissolution, the assets of the Association shall be disposed of in accordance with the decision of the General Assembly and applicable legal regulations.

#### **Article XI – Final Provisions**

1. These Articles enter into force on the date of registration of the Association in the public register.
